


Riverview Middle School Project Grant

Dr. Ted Schulz introduces our guest speaker, Walt Manos who is on the

Board of Directors of Rio Vision. Walt gave a program on Rio Vision's effort to build a Vegetable Garden at Riverview Middle School. They have received a matching grant of \$1,500. from Healthy Planet. Walt is very excited to live in Rio Vista and to be involved in Rio Vision. Rio Vision has built twelve 4 X 12 foot quality planter boxes. The students will have courses on the planting of seeds, growing of the plants and harvesting of the crops. The crops will be donated to the local Food



Bank. They have to raise \$1,200 in 2 weeks to keep the grant. Walt asks



Rotary members to step up and donate for the kids. Jim Lira donates \$600, Jim McPherson donates another \$600 and Derek Able donates \$300. After the meeting Walt collects checks from our 3 generous Rotarians. Walt takes their checks and heads over to Riverview Middle School to deliver the checks to the Principal.

Once Healthy Planet receives the checks, they will schedule October 28th for Healthy Planet representatives to come to Rio Vista to plant the crops.
