

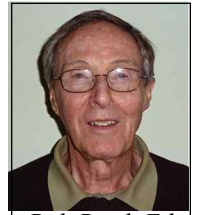

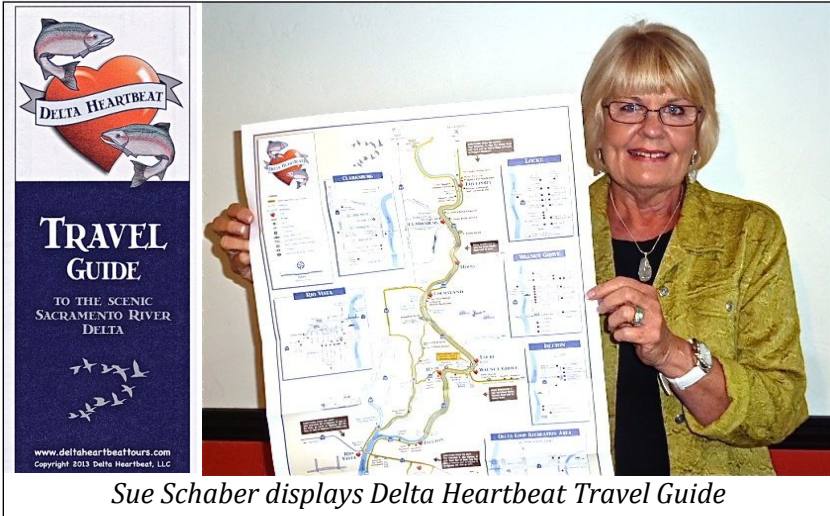

Who said, "The greatness of a nation can be judged by the way its animals are treated?" To Ted's dismay, no one knows it's a famous quote from Gandhi.

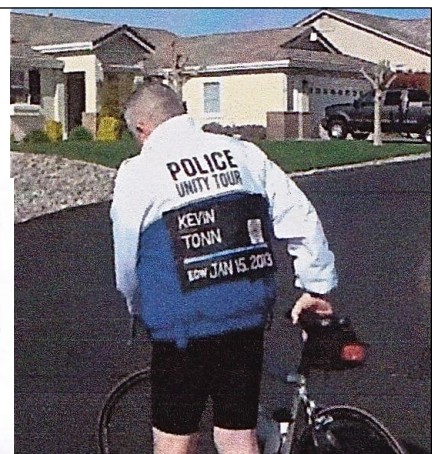
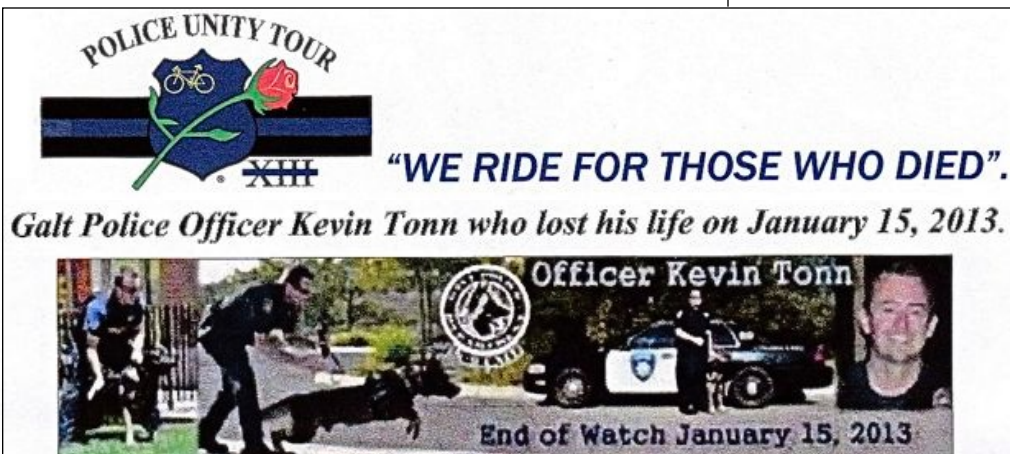
### Paint RV teal; raise awareness of sexual assault
